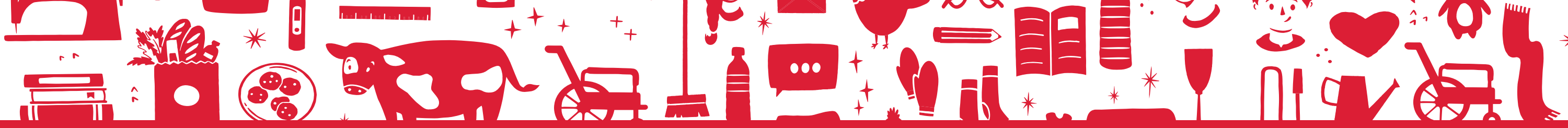

You may add several items you'd like to donate using the touch screen "shopping cart," up to a total of \$1,500.



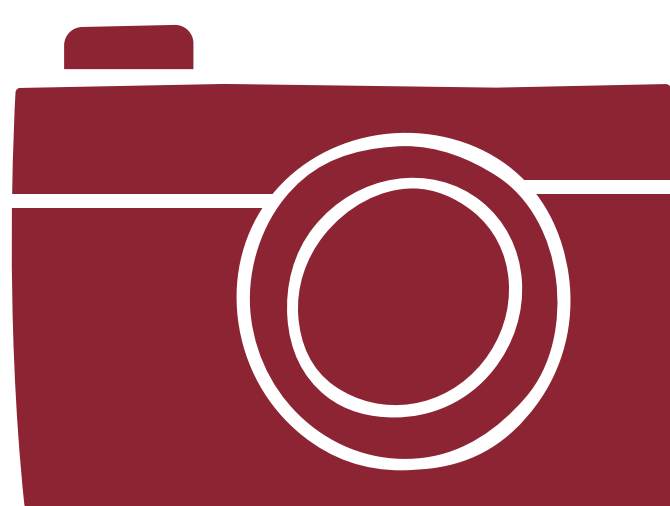
3. Swipe your card
